Job description

 The on-call crisis counsellor joins MSAC's emergency team which works in partnership with the Montreal General Hospital and CLSC Metro. Together they offer the medico-social intervention to francophone and anglophone adult sexual assault victims. This service responds to the needs of victims 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

The candidates that we are looking for must have:

- A BSW, D.E.S.S. in Social Work, an MSW.
- A BA or an MA in Sexology or Criminology.
- Candidates who are close to completing requirements for master's degree in Social Work, Sexology or Criminology will be considered.
- Have a general interest in the issue of violence against women. •
- Relevant job experience in intervention with sexual assault, sexual violence, and • crime victims.
- Be comfortable working in a medical environment and possess knowledge about • the Health and Social Services network.
- Be able to work autonomously and within a multidisciplinary team. •
- Very good command of French and English languages.
